

# City & Guilds Certificate in Electrical Epilation

---

This course is for beauty therapists who are interested in the knowledge and skills to provide permanent hair removal treatments. The skills developed by the learner include: communication skills, organisation skills, the ability to work unsupervised, how to adapt techniques according to the situation, the ability to complete a full electrical epilation treatments, how to promote services and advise on aftercare products. It includes the following knowledge.

- the range of equipment and resources required
- contra-indications which prevent or restrict electrical epilation treatments
- methods of electrical epilation
- selecting needle type
- the risks of using inappropriate needle size and incorrect needle insertion
- how to adjust equipment to aid effectiveness of treatment
- how to stretch skin tissues
- the importance of removing hair from the follicles without traction
- the contra-actions that may result from an electrical epilation treatment
- the aftercare advice that should be provided
- the effects on skin tissues and hair types of the different types of electrical current
- the effects of alternative forms of hair removal on skin and hair
- the structure and main function of the skin, hair and follicle
- the main diseases and disorders of the skin
- the effects of electrical epilation on body systems
- differences between the stages of the hair growth cycle
- the main causes of hair growth
- disorders of the endocrine system affect the condition of the hair and skin
